Frequently Asked Questions

Q. Why have we introduced a national membership system?

A. Our goal is to establish a membership structure to effectively engage with players, officials, coaches, schools, and fans throughout Scotland and supporters of the Scottish game throughout the world. This forms a critical part of our future strategy to grow the game in Scotland.

Q. What are the different categories?

A. There are five new membership categories designed for club members, coaches, fans and for supporters of the game who wish to make a donation to cricket development projects.

Q. What if I am already a personal member of Cricket Scotland?

A. The Personal membership category will continue however it is now closed for new membership. Personal members can join any of the new categories.

Q. Does the Membership system comply with Data protection

A. Our new Membership system is called Go Membership from a company called Azolve and is compliant with Data Protection laws. We are also working with Azolve and Sport Scotland to ensure the system will comply with new GDPR legislation coming into law in May 2018.

Q. Will my data be shared with 3rd parties?

A. No, Cricket Scotland will not share membership data with any 3rd parties without permission.

Q. Where will income from the paid memberships go?

A. The majority of income from paid memberships will go towards our regional and community cricket development projects. More information on this is available at cricketscotland.com/get-involved/membership

Q. Does any of money go to professional cricket?

A. No, income from memberships is re-invested in the club and youth development projects

Q. Have other Scottish sports implemented a membership system for their players and clubs?

A. Yes, the majority of Scottish sports have implemented a system and in many cases with an annual fee to players ranging from £10 to £45. We have decided not to charge club members for the Individual membership category.

Q. Can I join more than one category of membership?

A. Yes you can join multiple categories.

Q. Can members of my family also join?

A. At the moment any individual person can join but they require a unique email address. U-18s can join the Junior Saltire Club. We are looking at offering a family membership category for 2018.
