

International Matches - Ticket FAQ's

Q. How can I buy tickets for the Summer Internationals?

A. Tickets can be bought online at www.ticketline.co.uk or phone 0844 8889991 from 10am on Friday 25th January

Q. What will the price of tickets be?

A. Online tickets range from £20 to £37 including Fee and Youth (u-16) tickets are priced from £10 to £27 including fee.

Q. Will tickets be available on match days?

A. Tickets for some parts of the ground may be available on match days subject to demand.

Q. What do I do if I have lost my ticket?

A. A duplicate ticket, issued as a replacement for any ticket which has been stolen, lost or temporarily mislaid, will be issued by Ticketline only on production of a written statement by the person who originally purchased the ticket. If stolen, it is imperative that the theft is reported to the Police in order that a crime number can be allocated. This number is to be quoted on your written statement for duplicate tickets. An administrative charge of 10% of the face value will be made for each duplicate ticket.

Q. Can tickets be bought for a group?

A. Group tickets have been offered to affiliated cricket clubs. Should you have a group of 10 or more please contact tickets@cricketscotland.com.

Q. Are tickets available for hospitality?

A. Hospitality tickets may be available subject to demand - please contact Matchpoint.co.uk or call 0131 477 7755

Q. Will there be concession tickets?

A. There will be a limited number of Youth tickets available for each match on a first come first served basis. These will be offered at a reduced price to the adult ticket.

Q. Will tickets be available for the pavilion?

A. Tickets for pavilion access are not currently available for public sale.

Q. Can I bring children into the venue without a ticket?

A. Children under 4 years old are permitted into the venue without a ticket but are required to sit on their parent/guardian's lap. Youth tickets for u-16's will be available.

Q. How do I get a refund if less than 10 overs are bowled

A. Full refund details are available on the Match day page on www.cricketscotland.com.
