

International Matches – Venue FAQ's

Q. Can I bring a bag into the ground?

A. You may bring one bag no larger than 45cmx30cmx14cm. A bag search policy will be in place and therefore please allow time for queuing.

Q. What do I do if my bag is oversized?

A. There are no storage facilities for oversized bags therefore you will not be able to leave a bag outside the venue.

Q. Can I bring food and drink into the venue?

A. Food and soft drink are permitted into the venue. NO alcohol is permitted or glass bottles.

Q. Will there be food and alcohol available in the venue?

A. Yes there will be a number of catering and bar outlets in the venue.

Please be aware, the following items are NOT permitted to be taken into the ground:

Alcohol, Glass Bottles, Cans, Picnic Baskets, Weapons, Fireworks, Flares or Air Horns

Q. Can I bring children into the stadium?

A. Children under 4 years old permitted into the Stadium without a ticket but are required to sit on their parent/guardian's lap. Youth tickets for u-16's will be available.

Q. What time will the matches start?

A. Matches are due to start at 11am.

Q. Is there any parking at the venue?

A. No there is no parking at the venue. Metred parking is available North of the ground.

Q. Is fancy dress permitted?

A. Fancy dress is permitted however please ensure your costume will not cause offense.

Q. Can I bring a pushchair into the venue?

A. We advise against bringing pushchairs to the venue on match days. The venue will be very busy and unfortunately, we do not have any dedicated storage space.

Q. Can I pass out of the venue?

A. We operate a pass-out system which allows ticket-holders to leave and re-enter the venue. On leaving the venue, you will be issued with a wrist-pass which will be needed to re-enter the venue. You will also need to show your ticket in order to re-enter the venue.

No alcohol can be brought into the venue following a pass out and any bag will have to be searched again.
