We will be playing in the 2nd and 4th Divisions of the Western District Cricket Union, and had over 100 juniors last years at all age levels.

Job Overview:

We are looking for an experienced and enthusiastic Head Coach who is committed to growing the game through excellent listening and communications skills across all age groups. The Head Coach will also work with our volunteer coaches taking them to the next level of coaching. The successful candidate will have a proven track record and will work on various programmes linking with East Renfrewshire Active Schools, local voluntary and religious groups to expand our reach within the local area. These programmes include:

- Assist with East Renfrewshire Active Schools and Barrhead Community Sport Hub in their Primary and secondary schools Introduction to cricket programme.
- Deliver coaching for our expanding youth section including the national programmes “All Stars”, “Dynamos”, “Kwik Cricket” and junior league cricket.
- Mentor volunteer coaches who want to move to level 2 and above.
- Coach all seniors within the club’s membership.
- Help assist with Junior match days.
- Help coach and setting up of a “Woman & Girls” section within the club.
- Help run Schools competition and summer camps at cricket ground.
