



Men's National Squad Fielding Consultant (Fixed Term)

Our Men's National Squad have qualified for the ICC Men's T20 World Cup in West Indies and the USA, and we are looking for a Fielding Consultant, to support us during this time. This is a fixed term role, for a period of approx. 2 months (May-June 2024)

The Fielding Consultant has responsibility for the development and performance of Cricket Scotland men's national squad. In conjunction with the Head Coach, Coaching Staff and players, the Fielding Consultant will prepare the players both individually and as a team to compete successfully at the ICC Men's T20 World Cup.

The Fielding Consultant will:

- Develop, implement and monitor individual fielding development programmes for each player within the National squad in conjunction with CS skills coaches.
- Support (and on occasion be responsible for) the organisation of practice and preparation of the National squad for CS to compete successfully in the ICC Men's T20 World Cup.
- Support (and on occasion be responsible for) the preparation and implementation of 'of the national squad in a variety of skill disciplines in order for the team to be as prepared as possible to compete in ICC global events.

Knowledge, Skills, and Experience:

To be considered for this position, applicants must demonstrate:

- UKCC ICC/ECB Level 3 Coaching Qualification (completed or in progress).
- Demonstrable success as a cricket coach at domestic and/or international level.
- Experience of fielding coaching in professional cricket.
- Minimum of 5 years' experience within professional cricket.
- Ability to motivate and influence professional cricketers, coaches, and teams.
- Resilience and energy to operate in a challenging and high-profile working environment.
- Proven ability to operate with professionalism and integrity in challenging situations.

- Exceptional planning, co-ordination, and organisational skills.
- Self-motivated with the ability to work independently or as part of a team.

Desirable:

- ICC/ECB Level 4 Coaching Qualification or equivalent.
- International Coaching experience at major ICC tournaments.
- Self-contained operator with good computer/IT literacy.

Place of Work

During the course of this fixed term contract, you will work with the team in Scotland, before travelling to Netherlands and then West Indies for the ICC Men's T20 World Cup.
